

The Light That Still Shines

Christmas Day has passed. The carols may be quieter now, decorations beginning to come down, and life slowly returning to its familiar rhythms. Yet the season of Christmas is not over. On this Second Sunday after Christmas, the Gospel of John invites us to linger a little longer at the mystery of what we have just celebrated—and to see it with deeper eyes.

John's Gospel does not begin with shepherds or angels, mangers or magi. Instead, it takes us back before time itself: "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God." John reminds us that the child born in Bethlehem is no ordinary child. Jesus is the eternal Word through Whom all things were made—the voice of God speaking creation into being, now choosing to speak love into human flesh.

This Word, John tells us, "became flesh and lived among us." Some translations say He "dwelt" among us—literally, He pitched His tent with us. God did not remain distant or removed from the messiness of the world. Instead, God stepped into it fully: into our joys and sorrows, our hopes and fears, our brokenness and longing. Christmas is not simply about a baby in a manger; it is about God choosing to be present with us, right where we are.

John also speaks of light—light that shines in the darkness, light that the darkness cannot overcome. This is a powerful word for us as the new year approaches. We do not know what the months ahead will hold. Many carry burdens into this season: grief that feels heavy after the holidays, uncertainty about the future, struggles that did not disappear when Christmas arrived. John does not deny the reality of darkness. Instead, he boldly proclaims that darkness does not get the final word.

The light of Christ still shines. It shines in hospital rooms and quiet homes. It shines in acts of kindness, in forgiveness offered, in justice pursued, and in love lived out day by day. When we choose compassion over indifference, hope over despair, and faith over fear, we reflect that light into the brokenness of our world.

John also reminds us of an extraordinary promise: "To all who received Him... He gave power to become children of God." Christmas is not only about what God has done; it is about who we are becoming. Through Christ, we are claimed, named, and sent. We are called to live as children of light—bearing grace and truth into a world that desperately needs both.

As the glow of Christmas candles lingers, may we carry this truth with us: the Word has come near, the light still shines, and God is still at work—within us and through us. Christmas does not end; it continues in lives shaped by the love that became flesh for us all. How will we shine that light in the coming year?










Running With the Giants


