In and through baptism we are called to repentance, faithfulness, and discipleship. Baptism gives the church its identity and commissions the church for ministry. In infant baptism we testify to the world that God acts lovingly and graciously on our behalf before we have a chance to respond. This reminds us that we are loved in spite of our brokenness and provides a clear visual image of God's grace.
