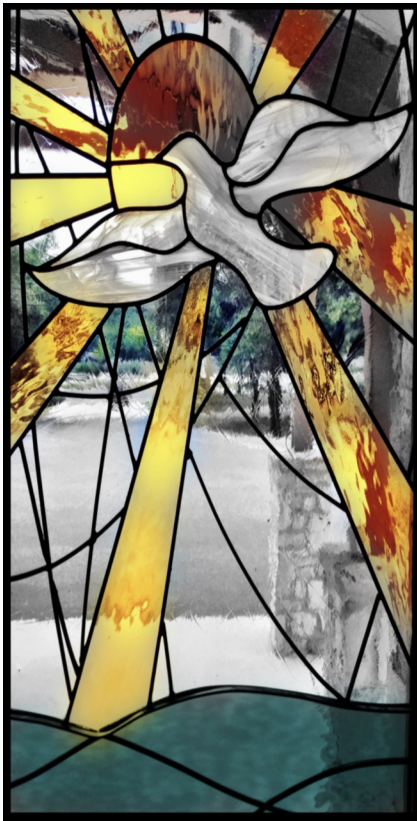

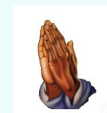

One God, Three Persons, Endless Love

Trinity Sunday can feel a little overwhelming at first, especially for someone who is new to the Christian faith. Even lifelong believers sometimes struggle to explain how God can be Father, Son, and Holy Spirit all at the same time. Yet Trinity Sunday is not simply about trying to solve a theological puzzle. It is about understanding who God is and discovering how deeply God desires a relationship with us.

As followers of Jesus, we believe there is one God who reveals Himself in three persons: God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit. The Father is the Creator who gives life and sustains all things. Jesus the Son is God who came near to us in human form, teaching us how to live and offering salvation through His death and resurrection. The Holy Spirit is God still present with us today, guiding, comforting, convicting, and strengthening believers every day.

For someone new to faith, Trinity Sunday reminds us that Christianity is rooted in relationship. From the very beginning, God's nature has been relational. The Father loves the Son, the Son obeys the Father, and the Holy Spirit unites and empowers. God's love is not distant or cold. It is living, active, and personal. That matters because many people today feel disconnected, lonely, or unsure where they belong. The Trinity shows us that we were created for loving relationship with God and with one another.

Trinity Sunday also reminds us that we encounter God in different ways throughout our lives. Sometimes we experience God as a loving Father who provides comfort and direction. Other times we encounter Jesus most clearly — walking beside us in suffering, forgiving our failures, and showing us grace. And often it is the Holy Spirit who gently nudges our hearts, gives us peace in difficult moments, or gives us courage to take the next faithful step.

The beauty of the Trinity is that God is always reaching toward us. We are never left alone to figure out life by ourselves. The Father created us intentionally. Jesus redeemed us sacrificially. The Holy Spirit walks with us daily. Trinity Sunday reminds us that every part of God's nature is centered on love.

As Christians, we may never fully understand the mystery of the Trinity, but we do not have to fully explain God in order to experience Him. Faith often begins not with having every answer, but with trusting the One who calls us by name. Trinity Sunday invites us to stand in awe of a God who is bigger than our understanding, yet close enough to know us personally and love us completely.

SonShine Singers

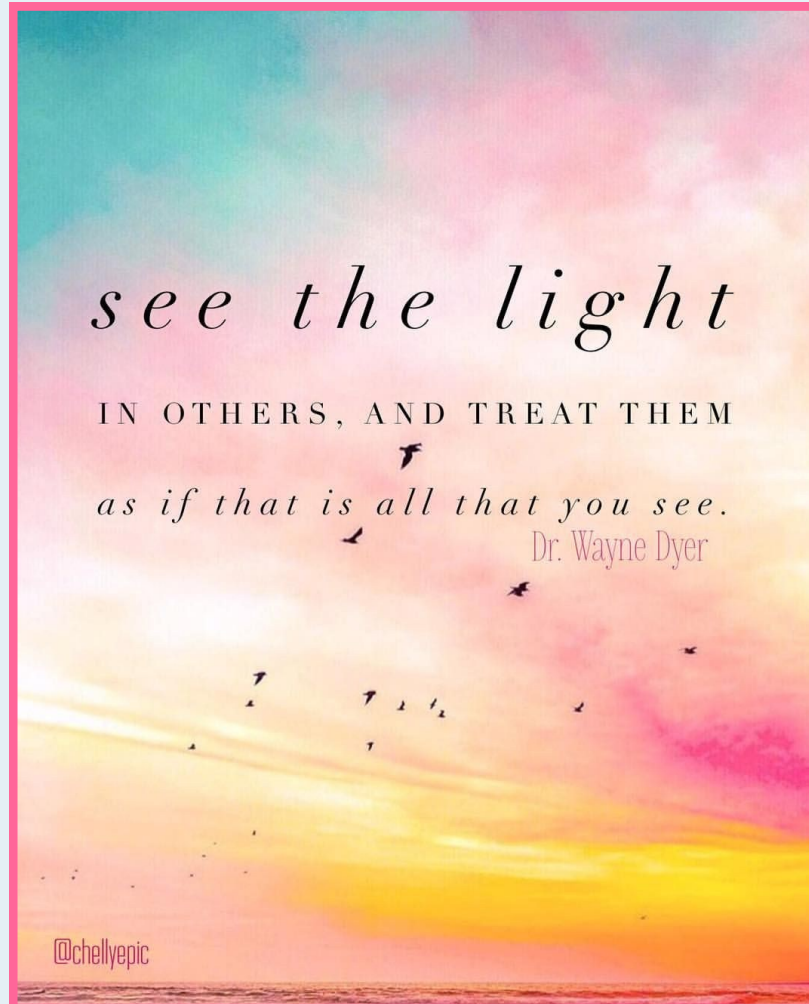
